FFY 2023 LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Georgia's regular Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) will open on November 1, at 8:30 a.m. for elderly and homebound households (all adults in household must be age 65 or over and/or physically/medically homebound) that meet eligibility requirements for the program. Applicants may CALL-IN* or Drive-Thru Tuesday, NOVEMBER 1, 2022. *The LIHEAP program is operated on a FIRST COME; FIRST SERVE BASIS AND FUNDING AVAILABILITY.

- GENERAL PUBLIC CAN NOT APPLY UNTIL Thursday, DECEMBER 1, 2022.
- Flyers will be posted in designed areas in your community.
- Drive Thru and CALL IN ONE DAY ONLY FROM 8:30 A.M. - 4:30 P.M.
- Appointments will be scheduled at a later date from the waiting list based on funding availability.

Applicants must be U.S. citizens or legally admitted aliens. Households participating in the program must meet income criteria and be responsible for the cost of heating their homes. To be eligible, households must have an annual income equal to or less than: \$28,050 for a one-person household; \$36,690 for two persons; \$45,324 for three persons; \$53,957 for four persons; \$62,591 for five persons; \$71,224 for six persons; \$72,842 for seven persons, \$74,461 for eight persons; and each additional person add \$1,619.00

All applicants will be asked to provide the following on the date of scheduled appointment:

- Most recent active heating bill or statement of service from the heating providers;
- Social Security Cards for each member in the household;
- Proof of Citizenship for each member in the household;
- Proof of income for each member in the household for the last 30 days
- (Proof of income includes paycheck stubs, a letter granting public assistance, social security or unemployment benefits, etc.); and
- All applicants will be required to sign consent to release information form allowing the state to retrieve energy usage data from their energy provider and to provide proof of bill payment.
